### **Forest Report**



Above is a typical picture of an area where target shooters are ruining the National Forests. It is filled with trash and hundreds of trees are now shot down or filled with bullets and will not be harvestable in future years. On top of that, the area is contaminated with highly toxic chemicals that will threaten people, wildlife, and fish.

These types of areas are everywhere, and shooters virtually never clean them up. We have seen less than 1% of target shooters clean up after shooting in National Forests, and this is after many years of observing them.

We continue to suggest that the forests be closed to recreational target shooting until they can be decontaminated and then opened back up with safe and legal shooting and be properly monitored.

The signs we maintain for the USFS are all up and functioning at this time.
